- C. Late applications for competitive examinations may be accepted if the examination has not been administered and an eligibility list established. This is provided that the late filer is a Government of Guam employee who can establish to the satisfaction of the Director of Education/ Superintendent, that they were unaware of the job announcement or unable to file a job application due to factors beyond their control (i.e. official off-island training, on extended annual or sick leave, etc.).

**904.107 Evaluation of Applications**

- A. Two months after the closing date of the position announcement, an eligibility list shall be established. Failure to establish an eligibility list within two months of the closing date will require that the position be re-announced with a new closing date, and that all applications previously received shall be re-stamped and re-accepted to coincide with the new announcement period.
- B. The closing date of the announcement shall be the ending date to credit the job applicant's education, experience and training for the position applied for. For continuous job announcements, the ending date to credit the job applicant's education, experience and training shall be the date of receipt of the application.

**904.108 Rejection of Applicants**

The Director of Education/Superintendent shall not be required to accept applications or, after acceptance and evaluation, establish an applicant as eligible on an eligibility list, or allow an applicant admission to an examination when any of the following conditions exists:

- A. Conviction of a crime within seven years prior to the date of application which bears a nexus to the position applied for, unless otherwise required by statute.
- B. Refusal or failure to furnish documents required to verify any statements made in the application.
- C. Intentional false statements or deception, or fraud in the
