# GUAM EDUCATION POLICY BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 2010-04 AMENDMENT OF TEACHER STANDARDS

Adopted June 30, 2010

# TEACHER I-A (Pay Grade ED1A)

A minimum of thirty (30) semester hours of college credits but less than a Bachelor's degree.

#### TEACHER I-B (Pay Grade ED1B)

A minimum of sixty (60) semester hours of college credits but less than a Bachelor's degree.

## **TEACHER I-C (Pay Grade ED1C)**

- a) Earned Bachelor's degree with less than eighteen (18) semester hours of professional education credits.
- b) A minimum of ninety (90) semester hours of college credits including twelve (12) semester hours of professional education credits, and two (2) years of teaching experience.

## TEACHER I-D (Pay Grade ED1D)

Earned Master's degree with less than eighteen (18) semester hours of professional education credits.

## **TEACHER II (Pay Grade ED2)**

Earned Bachelor's degree including at least eighteen (18) semester hours of professional education credits.

#### **TEACHER III (Pay Grade ED3)**

Earned Bachelor's degree including at least eighteen (18) semester hours of professional education credits, and at least eighteen (18) semester hours of college credits beyond the Bachelor's degree which must be upper division courses in the specialty area or graduate work, neither of which was applied to the Bachelor's degree.

#### TEACHER IV (Pay Grade ED4)

Earned Master's degree including at least eighteen (18) semester hours of professional education credits.

#### **TEACHER V (Pay Grade ED5)**

Graduation from a recognized college or university with a Master's degree including at least eighteen (18) semester hours of professional education credits, and thirty (30) semester hours of graduate credits beyond the Master's degree.

#### **TEACHER VI (Pay Grade ED6)**

Graduation from a recognized college or university with a terminal degree including at least eighteen (18) semester hours of professional credits.

#### **Necessary Special Qualification**

- 1. Pursuant to Board Policy 1000.2; or
- 2. Certification requirements as established by the Guam Commission for Educator Certification (Authority: P.L. 29-73)
