Tips to Support Virtual/Distance Learning for Students with Disabilities

- fer alternative means of completing assignments if it does not interfere wi

### Implement IEP

- Follow a consistent schedule/routine
- Document activities and services provided (contact log)
- Monitor and track student progress based on student's response to services provided during school closure

### RECOVERY EFFORTS

Once there is data to determine whether there was a loss of skills and/or progress during school closure, IEP team determines whether additional/new/different services and accommodations are needed to address the impact of school closure
