Please see below questions submitted by Prospective Bidder(s):

Price Elementary School

1. ON SHEET E 4.0, one line diagram new condition call out number 4, indicates we are installing Approximate 4000LF conduit. 5000LF #12 and 10000LF #10.

GDOE Response: As-built plans were not available during design. For Uniformity and Basis of the bids, these figures are allowances for bidding purposes. Actual conduits and wiring that will be used will be prorated accordingly. Allowances applicable to the indicated work note.

- a. RFI-1A. Please clarify if this conduit applies for the existing underground Conduit coming from existing Panel A to be converted to above ground.

GDOE Response: Yes.

- b. RFI-1B. Assume existing homerun conduit still usable. Can we re-used existing conduit?

GDOE Response: No.

- c. RFI-1C. Removal existing branch circuit for existing Panel A having active connected load.

GDOE Response: All branch circuits as indicated on the drawings.

- d. RFI-1D. On the construction phase. Are we allowed to work during night shift?

GDOE Response: Once awarded, a meeting will be arranged with the school principal to determine the work schedule.

2. ON SHEET E 4.0, One line diagram new condition call out number 5.

- a. RFI-2A. Replacement of compatible circuit breakers. Are this circuit breakers suitable and tested for the existing load? Some of the existing breakers are multiple connected load. Clarify if we are connecting the existing connected load in same configuration.

GDOE Response: New circuit breakers, wiring and/or conduits to match existing.

- b. RFI-2B. How many existing active load tested on Panel A?

GDOE Response: Circuit tracing is part of the scope of work as indicated on the plans.

- c. RFI-2C. Assume existing load connected to Panel A is powered. But if we trace the existing circuit and electrical device is not working. Please clarify if we still install the conduit and associated cables.

GDOE Response: Yes. Comply with the requirements of the drawings and specification sheet.

3. ON SHEET E 4.0, Electrical room Enclosure.
 - a. RFI-3A, Existing electrical Partition is wood. Is this to remain? If not please clarify what partition wall to be used.
GDOE Response: Existing wall to remain.
 - b. RFI-3B. Existing floor vinyl tiles are we replacing . This floor tiles will be affected during removal of existing exposed cables.
GDOE Response: Restore floor to match adjacent flooring.
4. ON Sheet E-5.0 Panel PA and Panel PC
 - a. RFI-4A. Replacement of compatible circuit breakers. Are these circuit breakers suitable and tested for the existing load? Some of the existing breakers are multiple connected load. Clarify if we are connecting the existing connected load in same configuration.
GDOE Response: New branch circuit breakers, conduits and/or wiring to match existing. Only one each terminal for each wire allowed. Provide splice for multiple wires prior to termination to circuit breaker as applicable.
 - b. RFI-4B. How many existing active load tested on Panel PA & PC?
GDOE Response: Loads not tested. Replace panel and breakers as indicated on the IFB.
 - c. RFI-4C. Assume existing load connected to Panel PA and PC is powered. But if we trace the existing circuit and electrical device is not working. Please clarify if we still install the conduit and associated cables.
GDOE Response: There is no panel PA. For panels PB and PC extent of conduits and wiring are within the electrical room only if necessary to extend branch circuits to the new replacement panel(s).
5. Panel Schedules
 - a. RFI-5A. Partial one line diagram new condition in sheet E-4.0 for Panel A , shows 2 -2P40Amps and 1 -2P150 amps circuit breaker. Panel A Schedule are all 1P20A. Are these circuit breakers part for the panel schedule.
GDOE Response: One-line diagram shows only partial panel A (with breaklines). Panel A to include circuit breakers shown on one-line diagram and panel schedule.
 - b. RFI-5B. Panel Schedule A has more than 42 circuit connected load. Clarify if we have two section of panel. If We have to two section, space for mounting of this panelboard need clarification.
GDOE Response: Two-section panel is acceptable. Provide shop drawing of electrical room layout per specifications.
 - c. RFI-5C. Panel A, Panel PA and PC. Specs Indicate a Surge protector. Clarify if we providing Surge protector for these three panels.
GDOE Response: Yes.

6. One-line Diagram.
 - a. Shows Load Shed Panel. Clarify the rating of the panel.
GDOE Response: Rating per manufacturer recommendation. Include associated sensors, CT's and other auxiliaries necessary for complete and usable system.
 - b. For Load panel shed. Are these connected load only removed to one existing panel clarify.
GDOE Response: Please refer to one-line diagram.
 - c. Connected load and circuit breakers tripping. Call-out indicates upgrade circuit breaker. Existing panel circuit breakers are obsolete. Clarify how to upgrade.
GDOE Response: Suggest to provide ECB and connect to existing panel bus. Provide lugs as required.
7. Removal of existing Electrical equipment and cables. Is the cafeteria and other building affected on the construction phase will be temporary shut-down. Clarify.
GDOE Response: Shut down required. Coordinate duration with GDOE Personnel / Principal.

8. Are we allowed to re-use the existing below grade conduits?

GDOE Response: No.

9. Is there a maximum timeline for the outage while in the process of replacing the panels?


GDOE Response: Coordinate outages with GDOE Personnel and School Principal.
