An employee of the government of Guam who is a parent shall be granted administrative leave for the purpose of child school-related activities, such as to find, enroll, or re-enroll the employee's child in a school or with a licensed child care provider, to meet with a teacher or other school official concerning the employee's child's performance, to volunteer parental-involvement time at the employee's child's school, or to participate in activities of the school or licensed child care provider of his or her child, including attendance at a graduation, school play, school fair, and related events, which shall be considered as attendance at an official meeting or conference under Rule No. 8.402 of the Personnel Rules and Regulations of the Department of Administration for the purposes of eligibility for administrative leave if the employee, prior to taking the time off, gives reasonable notice to the employer of the planned absence of the employee. flgm
