#### A Message from the President







#### This Month's Speaker:

#### Frank Rabon

Frank Rabon is synonymous with cultural dance practices on Guam as the founder of the TaoTao Tano' Cultural Dancers. Having been raised in local traditions, culture, and the language, Rabon still felt that the culture was not in its truest form because of Spanish and American influences. Thus, he began his research into pre-contact CHamoru culture with a particular interest in chants, dances, and songs. Rabon has dedicated 28 years to CHamoru song and dance, and inspired many to pursue CHamoru dance. As the creative director of Pa'a Taotao Tano', Rabon has provided cultural services to the community of Guam, through the Department of Education, the Guam Visitors Bureau and the Government of Guam's cultural agencies. Rabon has received "Master of Chamoru Dance", the "Lifetime Achievement Award" from the Guam Council of the Arts and Humanities, as well as an honorary masters in CHamoru culture from the University of Guam. 
